

# Sleep Sack with Seed Stitch Top

Gauge: 7 stitches = 2 inches

Using size 10 1/2 circular needles and worsted weight yarn, cast on 94. Place marker.

Join in the round, being careful not to twist the cast-on stitches.

**Round 1:** \* K1, p1; repeat from \* around. Slip marker.

**Round 2:** \* P1, k1; repeat from \* around. Slip marker.

Repeat rounds 1 and 2 until piece measures 4 inches.

Switch to knitting every stitch around and work until piece measure 19 inches.

Work decrease rounds as follows:

Decrease round 1: \* K2 together, K1, repeat from \* around.

Decrease round 2: Knit around.

Repeat the last 2 rounds once more.

Without casting off, cut the yarn leaving a 12 inch tail.

Thread the yarn onto a tapestry needle and pull through the stitches, removing them from the needle as you go.

Pull tight, knot, and hide yarn tails.
