Cotton woven

What it's typically used for:

quilts, sheets
t-shirts,
pants, shirts, zip-up jackets,
jeans
drapes, pillows

suits, skirts
blankets, jackets
cuffs, neckbands
sweatshirts

washcloths, bathrobes

What we will use it for:

quilts, sheets, toys
t-shirts, sleepers and nightgowns, tam hats, toys
jacket and pants
diaper bags
diaper bags
receiving blankets, burp cloths, bibs, washcloths
if it's sturdy...diaper bags
winter buntings
cuffs, neckbands, tam hat trim
jackets and pants, mittens, toys
sleepers
washcloths, burp cloths

Types of Fabric we DON'T use:

Double knit
Crepe de Shine/silky fabrics:
satin, taffeta, sheers, lace, lame`
Polyester Interlock knit
Ripstop Nylon
Robe velour
Sweater knit
Swimwear
Upholstery
Vinyl
Wool

What it's typically used for:

leisure suits, slacks
fancy dresses, silky blouses

dresses, tops
wind pants, wind breakers
bathrobes
sweaters
swimwear, exercise clothes
furniture
cushions
suits, skirts, blazers

Other sewing/craft items we can use:

Bias tape – 1/2” extra wide double fold or 1” single fold

1/4” elastic

fiberfill stuffing

stitch witchery on a roll

thread

quilt batting

washable yarn

Shower curtain liners for changing pads

zippers – 14” or longer (polyester teeth)

Equipment:

pins – straight pins and safety pins

sergers

sewing machines

scissors/shears

rotary cutters, blades, cutting mats & rotary rulers
